1. EVENT SCHEDULE

Last race to commence no later than 2:50pm

3. CONDUCTING AUTHORITY

North West Radio Yacht Racing Club Inc. and it's duly appointed Race Committee.

4. RULES

The regatta will be governed by The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013-2016 (RRS) as changed by Appendix E of the RRS - Radio Controlled Boat Racing Rules and this Notice of Race (NoR)

5. ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to financial members of ARYA (Inc), its affiliated clubs, and to members of a recognized Division Member of the International Sailing Federation-Radio Sailing Division. Social sailors are eligible upon payment of the appropriate Associate Membership and Insurance fees as detailed below. (NB these are in addition to the nominated entry fee).

6. REGISTRATION

Skippers must present themselves for registration with the race officials at the start of each days competition. Boats entered in RG65 class must comply with current RG65 rules. Boats entered in Dragon Force 65 Restricted Class must comply with current rules. A declaration to this effect is included on the entry form.

7. EVENT CATEGORY AND ADVERTISING

This event is classified under the ISAF Advertising Code Regulation 20.3.1 (b) as Category C. The Organisers reserve the right to advertising

according to Regulation 20.3

8. SCORING AND RACING SYSTEM

The event will be sailed in one fleet. RG65 and Dragon Force 65 will be scored separately.

9. MEASUREMENT

The Race Committee may direct that all boats entered in the event be check-measured or alternatively randomly select a number of boats for

check measurement. Random spot checks may be conducted throughout the duration of the event.

10. FREQUENCIES

For frequency bands other than 2.4 Ghz, each competitor is required to nominate a minimum of three (3) frequencies with their entry.

The listing of additional frequencies if available would be helpful. Permitted frequency bands are 27, 29, 36, 40MHz and 2.4 GHz.

11. PROTESTS

A Committee will be appointed to hear any protests arising from the event and may comprise competitors not involved in the incident. RRS 61.2

and 62.2 may be replaced by a verbal notification and hearing if all parties affected by the incident agree.
